

Better safe than sorry

Dear Grown-ups,

We would be grateful if you could follow our 'golden rules' for child safety during the little sharks sessions. Where the rules are common sense, we apologise for stating the obvious.

Thank you.

- 1. Do not park buggies, prams or pushchairs in front of the doors. Please use the buggy zone.**
- 2. The store room and kitchen are out of bounds to children unless accompanied by an adult who therefore takes responsibility for the safety of the child(ren).**
- 3. The stage is out of bounds to children.**
- 4. The toilets are out of bounds to unaccompanied children as access to the front door and road is possible.**
- 5. Remember to close the hall door behind you to ensure children do not have access to the front door and road. Please don't open the fire exits.**
- 6. Remember to keep hot drinks out of the reach of all children, even if your child is unlikely to reach for them.**
- 7. Keep your eye on the play apparatus in the middle of the room. If you see that a mat has moved or a piece of equipment has been placed in an unsafe place, please take appropriate steps to solve the problem.**
- 8. Please help keep children out of the store room while the toys are being cleared away. There isn't enough room in the room for grown-ups, big boxes of toys and toddlers.**

There is a First Aid kit in the Admin box by the front table. Yes, there are plasters in it.

Please note that the store room is a fire exit for upstairs hall users so little sharks equipment must not block the room. Please also note that it is the responsibility of all little sharks users to help tidy the hall after sessions.
